

LAKE BROMBACH SPECIAL PURPOSE ASSOCIATION REGULATION FOR THE PORT FACILITIES AT

The harbour facilities at Lake Brombach are facilities of the Lake Brombach special purpose association for recreation and sport. The following port rules have been issued for them:

§ 1

Obstructions and harassment by third parties are to be avoided. In particular, neither the bathing areas nor the operation of other recreational facilities may be disturbed. Cooking, grilling and lighting fires are not allowed. The natural surroundings and landscape must be looked after and protected.

§ 2

The special purpose association assumes no liability for accidents and damage of any kind.

§ 3

The instructions of the representatives of the special purpose association are to be followed.

§ 4

Only the boats marked according to the rental contract may be moored at the rented berths. Boats with a measured value (length x width) of not more than 23.5 are allowed to be moored on the jetties; exceptions may be permitted for recreational craft, provided that the operational and technical reasons (e.g. mooring dimensions, weight, risk of water server contamination) do not prevent this.

§ 5

Illegally moored or parked boats, vehicles, trailers, trestle supports or other equipment will be removed for a fee.

§ 6

Damage of any kind to the port facilities, boats and other facilities of the special purpose association must be reported immediately to the harbour master.

§ 7

Changes to port facilities are prohibited. The boats must be secured in such a way that damage to the jetties is avoided. Access to the port facilities must be kept closed.

§ 8

The areas in front of the slip ramps and the accesses are only allowed to be used by vehicles for transporting boats to and from the areas, but not for the transportation of equipment parts. The transport of boats to and from the port must be carried out swiftly. Boats may only be moored for a short time (max. 30 minutes) at the rigging docks; boats may be moored for a maximum of 2 hours at the other jetties.

§ 9

Fishing is not permitted in the harbour and bathing area. Swimming in the port area is not permitted.

§ 10

Parents are liable for their children. Children are to be supervised.

§ 11

It is forbidden to allow or throw fuel, oil, cleaning agents, faeces and waste of any kind into the lake.

§ 12

Large waste must not be deposited. Wastepaper bins are available for small waste. All facilities of the special purpose association must be kept clean.

§ 13

Outside the sailing season, the facilities in the water and on land may not be used with the exception of designated winter storage spots. Staying overnight in boats on water is only allowed within the port facilities on rented berths.

§ 14

Violations of these port regulations may result in the immediate loss of the berth.
